Strongest Drive, Except One

Animals operate by instinct rather than logic or reason. Most animals have a parental instinct that causes them to feed, protect and nurture their offspring. Instinct to migrate in birds and fish is detailed and powerful. The strongest instinct in the animal world is universally recognized to be the instinct for self-preservation.

However, unlike in animals, in humans made in God's image, God placed a sense of "ought," a spirit of altruism. The instinct for self-preservation is often overruled by it; human beings risk – often-even give – their lives to save others.

That is a factor in the powerful moral argument for the existence of a Good Creator God. (Preacher Talk, Spring 2016 – Faulkner University)
