Communion Meditation...

WHY JESUS CAME (2)

In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." – Matthew 3:1

Isaiah had prophecied "The voice of one crying in the wilderness" would prepare the way for the coming of the Lord. John was that voice, and he prepared the people for the coming king by calling them to repentance.

He said to the Pharisees and Sadducees, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Bear fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matthew 3:7-8).

When some asked what they should do, he replied by telling them how they should amend their ways to live ethical, "kingdom of God" centered lives (Luke 3:10-14).

In his preaching ministry, Jesus also preached "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe the gospel" (Mark 1:15). "And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease..." (Matthew 4:23).

This was just before the Sermon on the Mount where he told us how life in the kingdom of God looks.

This is not mere teaching about the rules for how to do church. This is proclaiming a new order of things in which (in the words of Mary) God "has brought down the mighty from their thrones and exalted those of humble estate; he has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty" (Luke 1:52-53).

Life in the kingdom means life in Christ. Paul described his preaching in Acts 20:21-25 as

- Testifying of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Testifying to the gospel of the grace of God
- Proclaiming the kingdom

Jesus came to call us to repent and believe the gospel of grace found in the kingdom of God. To remember Jesus is to remember this message as we examine ourselves.
